NB: Clear Round riders must pay the £2 medical cover fee even if NOT competing in the competitive classes.

NB. CLEAR ROUND – 'SCHOOLING' rounds may only be ridden in the first half hour. They must be ridden early and only allowed on the day at the organiser's discretion, according to the numbers present. You MAY be asked for a small additional fee according to your time taken in the arena, i.e. £5.

RULES & GUIDELINES

ALL MSRC COMPETITIONS ARE RUN UNDER THE AUSPICES OF THE BRITISH RIDING CLUB'S RULES. THESE MAY DIFFER FROM THOSE OF THE OTHER DISCIPLINES.

SHOWJUMPING IS JUDGED UNDER BRC RULES

Whips: Whips must not exceed 30" (.75m)

<u>Practice Fences</u>: Must NOT exceed the height of the round which is in progress

MEMBERSHIP NUMBERS: All members will be expected to know and quote their current membership number in order to qualify for the reduced entry fees for members.

DOGS: MUST be kept on leads and under control at ALL times.

PARKING: PLEASE PARK AS AND WHEN YOU ARE DIRECTED. THERE WILL NOT BE ENOUGH SPACE TO ALLOW TYING UP AROUND VEHICLES <u>PLEASE</u> CLEAN UP AFTER YOUR HORSE WITH THE EQUIPMENT PROVIDED. THANK YOU.

WEATHER CONDITIONS: If weather conditions look likely to cause cancellation, please ring the **Organiser** and <u>not</u> the venue, at a reasonable hour the night before the competition.

The RC Mobile phone **07813 791 827** will be operational on the day of the competition ONLY.

ROR

Rosettes for the highest placed horse registered with RoR will be given at each competition and a Challenge Trophy at the end of the season to be presented at the AGM to the member gaining most points with one registered horse during the whole year. This will include dressage and show jumping.
